



## **Pupil Premium- 2019-2020**

### **Identified Barriers to Educational Achievement faced by Eligible Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium**

Pupils at JWS have severe or profound and multiple learning difficulties. This significantly impacts on their ability to access opportunities and experiences in life. These activities form the basis for neurological development and learning. There is a wide range of need within the school and those eligible for Pupil Premium are not easily categorised as each pupil has individual needs.

At John Watson School we recognise that the following are further barriers to educational achievement for pupils eligible for funding

- A. Significant difficulties in Social Communication and language development which impacts self esteem and well being
- B. Literacy and Mathematical skills require specialist interventions
- C. Support for Metacognitive development to apply and generalise learnt skills in a variety of contexts
- D. Difficulty accessing community and social events
- E. A variety of Physical impairment/needs which limit experiences
- F. Post school - Life preparation
