

Work Shadowing

Sixth Form students all follow a bespoke curriculum linked to their Individual Learning Plan, which includes completing various Asdan qualifications.

On-site, students complete work-related learning at Venison House during the months March to September, where they are given opportunities to maintain the garden and grow fresh produce.

If they need to be given an opportunity to complete work shadowing linked to their learning plan, for example, an experience of work to develop individual work-related skills, a placement is found to meet their individual needs. Where possible we arrange this in their own local community. For example, we have a Year 14 student working in the local bakery, where tasks include wiping the tables in the cafe area. Another Year 14 student works in the village library returning books of different genres to the appropriate shelves in the library.
